MID-TERM VACATION CAMPS were held in 12 primary schools and 3 parishes under the title 'lighting lives unitedly'. A total of 457 children were present and the 7 resource persons were our trained beneficiary students.

VISIT OF GIRL SCOUTS TROOP FROM BELGIUM: As an exposure programme, a troop of Girl Scouts from Belgium were at the Centre from 1st July to 9th July. They had the opportunity to interact with the school children in rural areas, interact with the scouts of rural and urban areas, assist in medical health check up camps, interact with the inmates of Premdham psychiatry department - St Ignatius Hospital, Orphan children of Maria Vionney Home and witness the cultural life of rural India. Also, they were introduced to some of the challenges faced in rural areas. The troop spent their time diligently, gaining vast learning experiences and are sure have fond memories to cherish! We so appreciate their desire and goodwill to make this world a better place.

SANJEEVINI - THE KNOWLEDGE BOOK: continues in its endeavour to give a boost to children's literary talent and increase their knowledge. The Sanjeevini Children's Committee consists of 32 members and subscription of 1000 readers. The subscribers are children from rural communities. Monthly issues from May to November containing informative articles on health issues, current news, drawings, puzzles, General knowledge have been published and distributed. Likewise, a workshop was held for children to train and improve their writing skills.

BHARAT SEVAK SAMAJ (B.S.S.) COMMUNITY COLLEGE offers alternative learning skills for the rural youth (female) particularly the school drop outs and the higher secondary pass outs. 63 students are enrolled for different courses for the academic year 2016-17.

Minds enlightened with wisdom and knowledge, children, youth are marching forward towards a stronger future. Their personalities transformed they are today beacons of light for those who have none. There is a new beginning for women who had otherwise lost their way, the Self Help Groups giving them power to live worthy lives. Health has been brought into families with free mobile health camps in the villages. Today children are free, happy and healthy due to your one sacrifice to support this Centre. Thank you.

Your love reaching out to us in a far away land, our gratitude goes out to you amid the singing of minstrels and the symphony of the many jubilant voices. There is hope and thrill in the air as we say to you Merry Christmas & Happy New Year!!! You are remembered with gratitude as your supported child steps into a brand new dawn of a New Year and rejoices with you with warm wishes going up in the overflowing of a joyful heart.

The Centre as you have known is reaching out to many precious lives around the region. Lives are being changed perhaps forever with strength and hope filling every heart in need. The activities carried out from June - November are:

CHILDREN SUPPORTED UNDER CHILD SPONSORSHIP PROGRAMME:

Arcidiecézní Charita Praha = 694	The Joy Sowers = 137
Slovenska Katolícka Charita = 160	Goretti Stichting = 38

EFFECTIVE STUDY PLAN FOR 10TH GRADE STUDENTS: 25 students of 10th grade attended the session on study skills for success in exams.

PHASE I - CLUSTER LEVEL PARENTS AND BENEFICIARIES MEETING - Motivation For Developing Leadership Skills & Appraisal, cluster level meetings were held in 11 clusters in 28 villages. 390 children & 376 parents were present.

CHILDREN'S COMMITTEE MEETING (College Leaders):

PHASE I: 53 students assumed role of leaders to collaborate and implement the activities in the villages.

PHASE II: The second session was held at the Centre. 95 leaders attended this workshop that focused on appreciating leaders for their achievement in village level activities.

PARENT'S COMMITTEE MEETING: 54 adults came forward to represent the parents and support the centre to carry out programmes in the villages.

WORKSHOP FOR COLLEGE AND COURSE STUDENTS: 355 students were helped to develop a skillful personality. The workshop culminated with the distribution of fee to the students.

INSTITUTION VISITS: Visits to the institutions were carried out by the Village Animators to appraise students' performance and class attendance.

VISIT TO THE FAMILIES: The village animators carried out house visits of 37 beneficiaries for building good rapport and review. The school dropouts beneficiaries were motivated to enroll for vocational courses.

AROGYA RAKSHA HEALTH INSURANCE: Under this scheme, our beneficiaries & their families have access to low cost health care at the hospital. A total of 497 members have enrolled under the Health Scheme. 45 inpatients and 175 outpatients (June to November) have received the benefits of health insurance.

STAFF APPRAISAL: Review meetings are held at frequent intervals to plan, assess, and follow up of the programmes carried out.

DEEPAVALI CELEBRATION: were carried out in 12 areas, focusing on the message: Light - Knowledge, Unity & Way of Life. Children & parents presented their talents through Yakhshagana, competitions, Preparing Akashagudu (Lanterns) & Stars.

SELF HELP GROUPS - EVENTS OF SHGs: One new group has been formed and the total number of SHG's is 36. The 36 SHGs conducted monthly meetings, collected monthly savings, repaid loan. To raise environmental awareness, 9 groups organized Environment Day in Schools. In June, prepared yearly planner for SHG, July - awareness on importance of Environment protection, Cardiac Problems and Prevention, September - Importance of saving water resources, Awareness on Malaria, viral fever, Unity, October - Encouragement for organizing Deepavali Programme. Average 398 women are regular for meetings.

CLUSTER LEVEL SHG MEETING - PHASE I: This was aimed to evaluate the activities of 3 months, to raise awareness on harmful health effects of tobacco consumption and to motivate people to seek treatment. These awareness programmes were held in 8 clusters. 31 SHGs participated in it. Female addiction to tobacco is on the rise in the villages and hence this information was quite handy for the Members to take initiative to curb the habit.

PREPARATION FOR GREEN INDIA - VANAMAHOOTSAVA: 65 members from 6 SHGs organized Vanamahotsava programme in 4 Higher Primary Schools. They planted flowering plants, vegetables & fruit plants. Children and women of SHG's were educated in promoting environmental awareness in their own communities by being environmental stewards.

PAPAD MAKING - 5 Self Help Group members are engaged in preparing papads and are on the path of becoming financially independent.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH PROGRAMME

HEALTH AWARENESS PROGRAMME: was held at Shree Chennakeshava High School Health on the topic 'Personal hygiene'. 270 students and 9 teachers attended the session.

This was followed by the session on Value Education, Health & Hygiene at Higher Primary School Prabhathnagar. 110 students participated in it.

From June to September 40 Awareness Programmes have been organized in 23 villages of Honavar Taluk with people being educated on Health related topics such as piles, breast cancer, diabetes, Hernia, de-addiction, etc.

-FREE HEALTH CHECK UP CAMPS: 13 health check up camps were conducted. Dr. Santosh K. - Surgeon, Dr. Kenneth C. - General Physician, Dr. Sunil M. - ENT Specialist, Physiotherapist Dr. Ajay Varma and Dr. Maria were the resource persons. A total of 1298 people have received benefits of free health checkup, medicine and concession cards. 700 Patients have come for follow up at St. Ignatius Hospital.

MID - TERM VACATION CAMP - TRAINING PROGRAMME: "Then beneficiary Today Village level resource Person" - 7 of our Child Sponsorship beneficiaries were given an opportunity to unearth their leadership potentials and act as resource persons for the vacation camps for primary school children and for that reason a training programme was held at the Centre for the selected students, 4 village animators and 8 staff.
